## POLLINATE ENTRY FORM

Beetles, bees, butterflies, bats, birds, flies, wasps, wind, water and even people can all be agents of the continuation of life on our planet by bringing the life force of one being to that of another, so that the seed of a new one can grow. Somewhere between 75% and 95% of all flowering plants on the earth need help with pollination. Another way to say this is that one out of every three bites of food we eat is there because of the work of pollinators. ArtHaus and the Northeast Iowa Pollinator Partners invite you to celebrate this in Pollinate, a community art exhibition of visual art that honors and hopes to inspire conversation about pollination and our environment.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

Any age or skill level is invited to submit wall-hangible visual art for inclusion in this community exhibit, to be on display at ArtHaus from Friday, June 3 through Thursday, July 21. All forms of media will be accepted including but not limited to painting, drawing, ceramic, fiber arts, jewelry, printmaking, and photography. **All works must be suitable for mounting on the wall; no free-standing works can be considered**. It is preferred that artworks be adequately prepared for installation (*framed and matted*) but it is not necessary as tacks, clips, and other methods of hanging loose paper will be used. All works must relate to the idea of pollination.

## **GUIDELINES**

Artwork must be labeled on the back with: Artist's name, Artist's phone number, Artist's email, and information about the artwork including title, media, year created, and sale price (*if applicable*). The bottom of this form may be used. All submissions must be accompanied by a completed and signed entry form. There is no fee to submit work(s).

Works should be delivered to ArtHaus at 508 West Water Street in downtown Decorah from May 20 through May 27, on Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays between 10am and 2pm. Dropoff appointments at other times are possible; please call ahead. Works can also be shipped to ArtHaus at 508 West Water Street, Decorah, IA, 52101. Shipping to and from ArtHaus will be the responsibility of the artist or person providing the artwork.

There will be an opening reception open to the public on Friday, June 3 from 6-8pm. The exhibition runs through July 21; works must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition.

Works listed for sale will be made available for purchase through ArtHaus, with 70% to the artist and 30% to ArtHaus should work(s) sell; artwork sales will support the ArtHaus' need-based scholarship fund. The exhibit is sponsored by Seed Savers Exchange and the Oneota Community Food Co-op.
